Dear Princeton Parents, Guardians, Students, Staff, and Community Members,

We have been eagerly awaiting the news and details that will allow Princeton employees to have the option to receive their COVID-19 vaccinations. Please see below for the most current information.

Princeton City Schools has buildings that fall under the jurisdiction of Hamilton County and the City of Springdale Health Departments. Therefore, the staff at Springdale Elementary School and Heritage Hill Elementary School will be partnering with the City of Springdale Health Department to be vaccinated today, on Friday, February 5, 2021.

The rest of our school staff members will be partnering with Mercy Health Fairfield and to receive the vaccine on February 11, 2021.

Please make note of this important information:

- **February 10:** PHS & PCMS Virtual Conferences
- **February 11:** No School for Students; Professional Development Day
- **February 12:** No School; Conference Exchange Day
- **February 15:** Presidents' Day

As you may know, the COVID-19 vaccines require a second dose. This has been scheduled, resulting in the following changes:

- **March 11:** Virtual Learning Day for ALL Students; Staff will receive a second vaccine.
- **March 12:** End of Quarter; Virtual Learning Day for ALL Students.
- **March 15:** In-person learning shifts to Scarlet and Gray Learning students combined.

While we know that unexpected school closures and schedule changes can be difficult for some families, it is our hope that the advanced notice will be helpful with your planning. It is important for our staff to receive the vaccine so that we can maintain in-person learning and finish the school year strong. We appreciate your cooperation and understanding.

We will share more details as they become available, but we wanted to share this exciting news as we look forward to being able to bring back our Scarlet and Gray Learning Week students on campus together.
