The program functions as a peer support team (with trained adult advisors) that focuses on providing kindness, encouragement and support for students who may be struggling. Hope Squad members are nominated by their peers and are trained to refer peers to trusted adult help within the school. They are not asked to act as a counselor, but are trained to recognize warning signs and seek adult help for peers. It is a social-emotional wellness screener that quickly assesses social-emotional wellness of students grades 3 through adulthood. The survey assesses the students level of risk or resilience (across 13 core indicators) and has lessons/curriculum to target risk areas assessed by the survey.
