Dear Princeton High School Staff and Students,

This letter is to notify you that a student or staff member at Princeton High School has been diagnosed with COVID-19. In order to contain the spread of this infection, we are asking you to monitor for symptoms, stay home when sick and see a physician for testing and treatment if you observe any signs or symptoms of COVID-19. Please take this letter with you when you go to your physician. The period of observing yourself related to this exposure ends October 13, 2020.

Here are the steps we need you to do to protect our community:

- Please monitor yourself for symptoms of COVID-19, which may include cough, shortness of breath, new smell disorder, or new taste disorder. Other symptoms include fever (measured or subjective), shivering with chills, body aches, headache, sore throat, nausea or vomiting, diarrhea, fatigue, congestion or runny nose.
- If you develop symptoms consistent with COVID-19 please stay at home and consult with your physician regarding next steps.
- Please notify school administration if you choose to get tested or if you develop symptoms.

The overall health and well-being of the students and employees at Princeton High School and throughout Hamilton County continues to be our top priority. Thank you for your cooperation in keeping our community healthy.
