Dear Princeton Parents, Guardians, Students, Staff, and Community Members,

We were informed yesterday, August 25th that there is a student who was informed of testing positive for COVID-19 on Tuesday, August 24th based on a COVID-19 test the same day. Per our protocol, we are notifying staff and parents in the **Princeton High School** community regarding this positive COVID-19 identification. Cleaning and disinfecting of the exposed locations have been completed.

The student's last day on site was Thursday, August 19th. The student is in quarantine at this time and won't return to campus before Tuesday, September 7th. There are no known exposure risks related to this case. According to Hamilton County Public Health, any known close contacts will be notified directly by the health department.

While your child was not exposed, the health departments want us to share the importance of continuing to monitor your child's health, keep sick children at home, and take them to see a physician for testing and treatment if you observe any signs or symptoms of COVID-19.

The overall health and well-being of our students and staff continue to be our top priority. Your mental health is just as important as your physical health.
