

CareerX Information Night

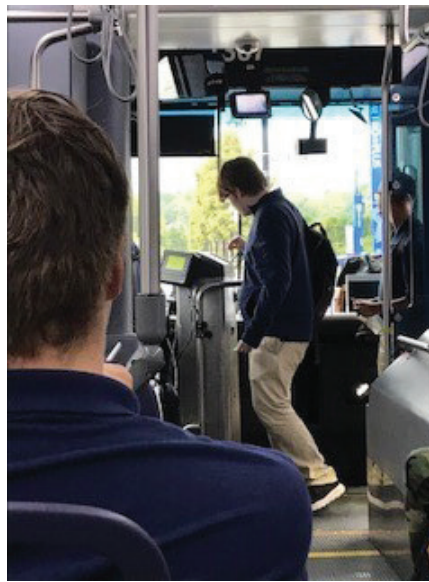


Please attend one of the sessions listed below, preferably the campus which corresponds with your home address. Parent or legal guardian should attend one of the information sessions.

As an entry-level transition high school program designed to assist students in making career choices, each student will explore five career areas through a series of activities to learn entry-level industry appropriate employability skills. The outcome of the CareerX program is to help each student narrow their interests, skills and aptitudes in order to move to their next transitional step toward competitive employment.

Upon completion of this program, a student who meets specified requirements could possibly enter into:

- Competitive employment with referral to an adult agency (OOD/DDS)
- Referral to an adult agency
