What is Key Club?

“Key Club is an International student-led organization which provides its members with opportunities to provide service, build character and develop leadership skills.

What do I have to do to be in Key Club?

Being a Key Club member is not based on your GPA but your willingness to serve others through community service!

REQUIREMENTS (to be in good standing)

- Each member must pay their Key Club dues (\$20) by mid October.
- Each member of the club must be willing to perform at least 50 hours of combined service of his/her school, home and community annually.

*Any services performed outside of club-sponsored services must be submitted and pre-approved by the faculty advisor in advance.

What types of Community Service things does Key Club do?

The Pop Tab Challenge...Key Club collects Pop Tabs all year long! All the tabs are recycled and the money goes to the **Ronald McDonald House of Greater Cincinnati**. You will only receive a maximum of 10 hours of service credits.

We volunteer for a variety of projects with *Matthew 25 Ministries, Hands Against Hunger, Babysitting, Special event Nights, Carnivals, along with mentoring programs and more for all the community elementary schools and PTA & PFO events and help out with the Sharonville/ Princeton Kiwanis Club projects.*
