## **WHO IS JOAN MEIER? WHY IS A MEMBERSHIP LEVEL NAMED IN HER HONOR?**

Joan Meier, Princeton Music Teacher, Leader Colleague, Advocate, Visionary, and Friend (taught 1960-1995) oversaw the development of the Princeton music program into one worthy of state and national recognition. Under her leadership Princeton music educators were empowered to develop superior programs, enabling many thousands of students to experience a comprehensive education in music. Fondly known as "Mother Meier," choirs under her direction consistently received Superior ratings. Her service to the music profession was recognized in many ways throughout her career, including statewide office and receipt of the OMEA Distinguished Service Award. Her legacy of high achievement and commitment to music education remain an integral part of the education program in the Princeton City School District.
